KIC has a great story to tell over the last six months.

Ministry Side: 2020 began with a smooth joining with SJK.

- The first Welcome Dinner in the new phase on March 1st followed by a two weeks outreach went well with 90 people attending the Welcome Dinner and 84 people joining the church service.
- The lock down soon after has put us in a very difficult situation to make any further follow up with the new contacts.
- We decided to move to online starting with the Prayer Meeting on Friday and in two weeks our Ministry Team specially constituted for this period gave us the signal that we can move all activities online including the Sunday Service.
- So we purchased Zoom Package and moved into online completely.

Ministry Team

Jeffy Philip, our student Intern led this team of seven enthusiastic young leaders and they divided the team into three operational areas:

- (1) Worship Team
 - (2) Pastoral Care
 - (3) Communication and Media
- **Worship Team** led by Samuel John began recording songs for the zoom service each week
 - **Pastoral Care Team** led by Rebecca John divided the entire church into different zones and choose leaders to take care each one's need.
 - On Easter Sunday with their own initiative and expense, they bought stuff that were packed into gifts packs and dropped every home of our members were remarkable.
 - They further enthused the members to support the financial helps to those international students struggling to meet their needs.
 - Many hands joined with them in this endeavour and Janice Blackly offered to offer coordinating this with her financial background was a great success.
 - Over \$6000 raised and supported the students in four rounds.
 - **Communication and Media Team** led by Marianne John have done marvellous way to reach everyone through Facebook/Facebook page, KIC webpage, and Instagram.
 - Began devotional video talk involving as many members as possible two per week for first month and later reducing to one per week because of too much of work
 - Sunday Zoom Service has been recording and posting it to KIC Facebook and Facebook page and in our website every week.

Zoom Sunday Service and Bible Study

- We thought it a golden opportunity to connect with the KIC Alumni from various countries, especially who do not have any provision for worship.
- We included an Alumni testimony in the service each week and listening to their stories how the Lord has been guiding them after the left KIC.

- We learned that many never had an opportunity to go to a church service. Some have chosen to be under our pastoral care ever since.
- Our Sunday services are attended over 50 to 60 people on average.
- Sunday Night Bible study too getting good numbers and even the Alumni who joins the service getting on to the Bible study as well.
